Thomas-Foreman Home

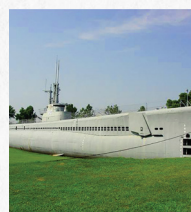
Take a tour of this historic home, built in 1898, and learn about the famous Oklahomans who called it home.

Family Fun

Muskogee Little Theatre

There's no need to travel to the Big Apple to see a show-stopping performance. You can catch one right here in Muskogee. MLT hosts multiple live productions throughout the year. Check their calendar and book your tickets!

The Butterfly Papilion

River Country Water Park

Thunderbird Speedway

Parks & Rec

Honor Heights Park

This 132-acre park is the crown jewel of Muskogee. No matter the season, Honor Heights's magnificence leaves visitors in awe. Take a walk around the five lakes and ponds, play in the splash pad, fish, and play a game of tennis. You can also attend one of the many activities, including Symphony in the Park and the famous Azalea Festival, that happens here. In the winter, the park turns into The Garden of Lights, a magical Christmas experience.

Love-Hatbox Sports Complex

With ten baseball fields, eight softball fields, two football fields, and The Georgia Pacific Soccer Complex, Love-Hatbox is a sports lovers paradise. There is also a covered picnic area and paved walking trail making it a great place to walk or ride your bike. This venue is used for livestock shows, Jeep Jam, the Muskogee Balloon Festival, and more!

Three Forks Harbor

Named for the three rivers that converge in Muskogee, the harbor is great for boaters, fishermen, hikers, bikers, and outdoor enthusiasts. Not only is it beautiful, but you can find fun events like the Kids Fishing Rodeo, the River Rumba, the Cardboard Boat Regatta, and the Bassmaster Opens.

The Depot Green

The Depot Green is one of Muskogee's newest attractions located in downtown Muskogee and quickly becoming a community favorite. It's a great space to picnic, play a game of catch, or bask in the sun. There's always an event, like the Localmotion Art Festival, the Christmas Train, or free movie showings.

HOME OF HISTORY

The historic Jefferson Highway, built to promote interstate travel, ran right through Muskogee. In 1921, a car campsite was built where passengers could stop and stretch their legs at what is now Spaulding Park. The campsite had showers, restrooms, and cooking facilities for travelers to use. The Jefferson Highway remains a large part of Muskogee's history.



Muskogee's history stretches beyond the road and into our notable neighborhoods. Many influential people have called Muskogee home throughout the years. You can find their beautiful homes, like the Thomas-Foreman Home located in areas like Founders' Place & Kendall Boulevard. If you enjoy architecture, you'll love driving through these landmark neighborhoods.
