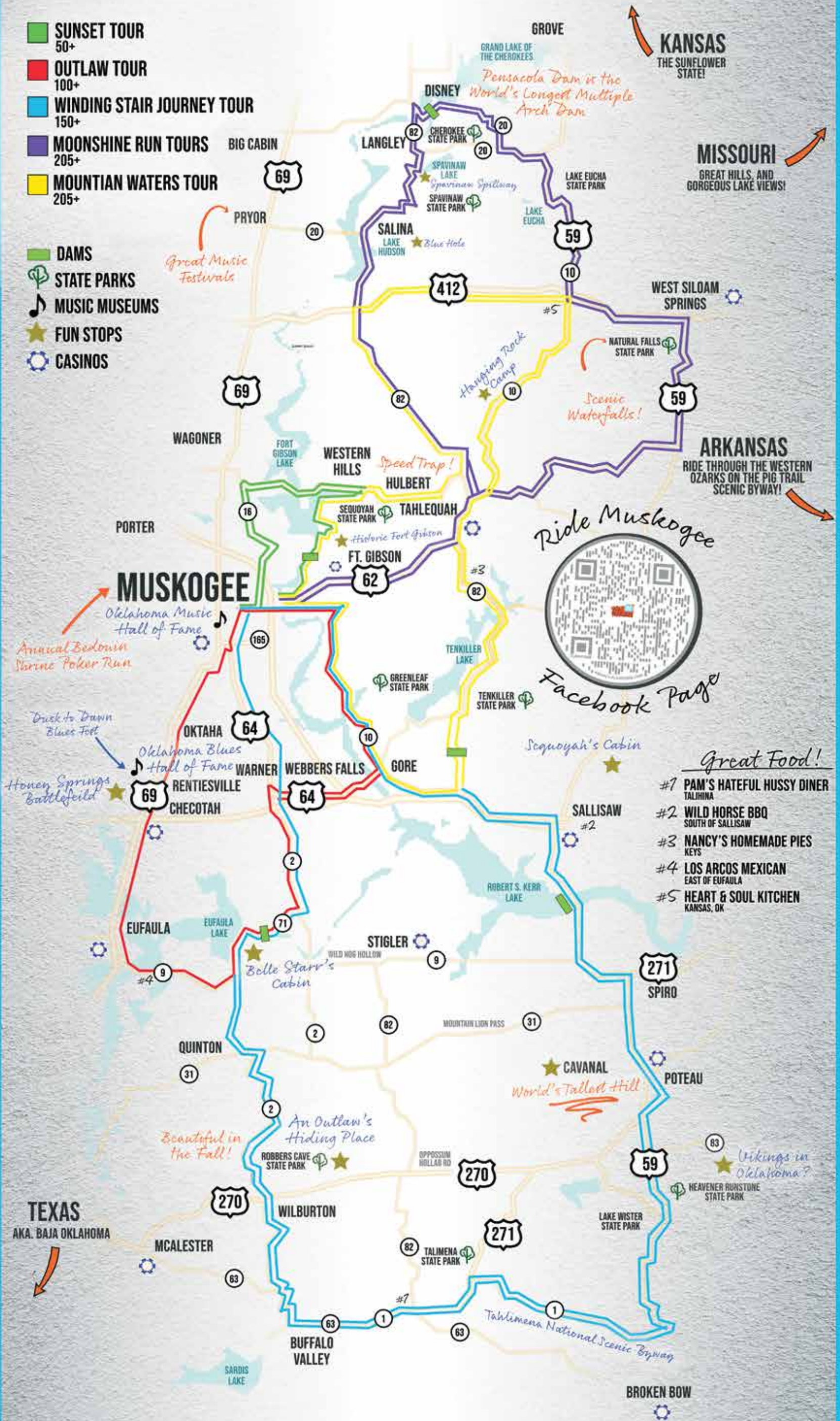


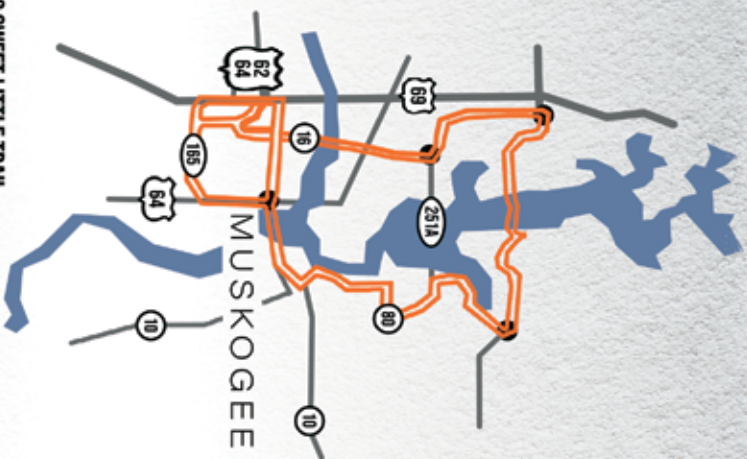

YOU'LL WANT TO PACK A PICNIC TO ENJOY ALONG THE WAY WITH SOMEONE SPECIAL. THEN, LET THE BREEZE OFF THE LAKE EASE THE TENSIONS WAY AS YOU MARVEL AT THE MAJESTY OF AN EAGLE SOARING ABOVE ITS NESTING GROUNDS. IT'S ONLY AN HOUR-ON DRIVE, SO IT FEELS LIKE TAKING THE LONG WAY HOME.

STRADDLING THE SADDLE FOR THIS RIDE THAT WILL TAKE YOU INTO THE TERRITORY OF BELLE STARR, THE JAMES BROTHERS, AND THE COOK GANG, YOU'LL FIND THAT "THE DRIVE IS FINE ON 69". THE HIGHWAY ONCE KNOWN AS THE JEFFERSON HIGHWAY, IF YOU HAVE THE TIME, A SIDE EXCURSION TO THE HONEY SPRINGS BATTLEFIELD WILL INTEREST THE CIVIL WAR BUFFS, OR YOU CAN TAKE A SHOPPING SPREE IN DOWNTOWN EUFAULA. THEN, ZIP OVER TO PORUM WHERE THE BULLET HOLES FROM A CATTLE RANGE WAR CAN STILL BE FOUND IN A BARN OR TWO. FROM THERE, A SHADED, WINDING HIGHWAY 10 WILL LEAD YOU THROUGH THE CAPITAL OF THE CHEROKEE NATION.

MOUNTAIN WATERS TOUR



THIS RIDE SHOWS YOU JUST WHY THIS REGION HAS EARNED THE NICKNAME GREEN COUNTRY. THE SPARKLING WATERS OF THE LAKES, CREEKS, AND RIVERS CREATE A LUSH CANOPY OF GREEN OVER YOUR GYPSY RIDE. TRAVEL THROUGH THE QUAIN TOWNS OF TALLEQUAH AND FORT GIBSON AND TAKE SOME TIME TO EXPLORE THEIR DOWNTOWNS AREAS. AS YOU RIDE ALONG THE ILLINOIS RIVER, YOU'LL ENJOY THE BEAUTY OF TWO LAKES—FORT GIBSON AND TENKILLER. HIGHWAY 80 WILL TAKE YOU PAST THE HISTORIC FORT GIBSON STOCKADE, WORTH A STOP TO LOOK AROUND.

MOONSHINE RUN



THE TERM 'BOOTLEGGERS' PROBABLY GOT ITS START SOMEWHERE ALONG THIS ROUTE. FOR A TERRITORY THAT WAS SUPPOSED TO BE DRY, IT WAS ANYTHING BUT. COWBOYS WOULD SLIP FLASKS INTO THEIR BOOT TO SMUGGLE CONTRABAND IN FROM ARKANSAS. THE BACK ROADS BETWEEN SILDOM SPRINGS AND MUSKOGEE WERE WELL KNOWN TO THE YOUNG MEN WHO EARNED SOME EXTRA CASH ON THE MOONSHINE RUN. THE COOKSON HILLS, PICTURESQUE AND PEACEFUL TODAY, HID MANY COPPER STILLS AT ONE TIME THAT KEPT FEDERAL MARSHALS UP IN ARMS. TODAY, THIS ROAD STILL HAS A LITTLE BIT OF REBEL ATTITUDE. FOR A TRULY WILD BEAUTY, STOP AT NATURAL FALLS STATE PARKED AND STEP INTO A PLACE THAT FEELS FROZEN IN TIME.

ADVENTURE AWAITS YOU ON THIS ROAD WHERE EVERY MILE IS A DELIGHT. EXHILARATING RIBBONS OF PAVEMENT WIND THROUGH THESE MOUNTAINS THAT GROW HIGHER AND HIGHER TOWARDS THE SKY IN LAYERS OF SMOKY BLUE. YOU'RE IN CHOCTAW COUNTRY NOW, AN AREA KNOWN AS 'LITTLE DIXIE' FOR ITS POLITICS AND SOUTHERN COMFORT, AND UNMISTAKABLE PERSONALITY. THIS ROAD WILL TAKE YOU PAST THE WORLD'S TALLEST HILL. EXCURSIONS TO ROBBERS CAVE STATE PARK AND THE SPIRO INDIAN MOUNDS MAKE THIS DAY AN ALL-DAY JOURNEY A RIDE TO REMEMBER
